**6th Annual North Los Angeles County Youth Championships
Cathy Wells Memorial 2012 City Tournament Rules**

1. Choice of date and time shall be given according to the order which entries are received by the North Los Angeles County USBC Association (NLAC USBC) Association Manager.
2. Any NLAC-USBC youth member is eligible. Youth bowlers from associations outside these areas must bowl a minimum of 3 league sessions within this association to be eligible; they must present a transfer card & an actual membership card when entries are submitted. There shall be no BLIND scores or pacers.
3. Check-in begins 45 minutes before the posted squad time. Do not arrive late, as tardy bowlers receive ZERO for frames missed. Please bring USBC membership cards to check-in. All team members must check in together for team event. Squads may start earlier, if everyone has checked in.
4. **Lineup:** Order cannot be changed from original entry form. Subs bowl in the position of original bowler. Substitute bowler forms are available from the NLAC Office before the tournament or on-site, as needed.
5. **Attire:** Dress appropriately for a championship. No bare midriffs or underwear showing. No cut-offs, tank or halter-tops, alcohol, tobacco, gambling or derogatory slogans. No sweats or warm up suits. Skirts and shorts must be no shorter than 3 inches above the knee. No hats or headgear except for religious or medical reasons.
6. No smoking during tournament play. Non-alcoholic drinks and food are permissible in the back area only. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of youth bowling in conjunction with USBC will result in immediate disqualification (Refer to rule 17D).
7. **Team entry fee:** \$9 lineage + \$10 prize + \$1 exp. = \$20 per person. **Doubles/Singles entry fee:** \$9 lineage + \$10 prize + \$1 exp. = \$20 per event. Only approved refunds at the discretion of the Tournament Manager allowed after the closing date. No refunds after the closing date.
8. Trophies will be awarded at least one (1) for every ten (10) entries per division. Awards and Scholarship fees shall be returned 100% to the bowlers. Scholarships will be held with the USBC SMART program under account #10677, (800) 514-2695 x8292. *USBC Rules 301d and 309 states that all scholarships must be deposited in the SMART Program.
9. Divisions with less than 4 entries will be combined with the next highest division. Tournament Director reserves the right to cancel any squad with 10 or fewer entries.

10. ENTERING AVERAGES:

- a. Highest USBC certified average as of **Jan. 1, 2012** (minimum 7 league sessions), if none,
- b. Highest USBC certified **Current** average as of the tournament date (minimum 7 league sessions), if none,
- c. Highest USBC Final **Summer 2011** average, if none,
- d. Highest USBC certified average as of **April 15, 2011**, if none,
- e. Enter at 210

Tournament Director has the right to adjust a bowler's entering average.

11. HANDICAP: 100% of 210

12. Once a replacement has started an event, they must complete that event except in the case of an emergency.
13. **Team:** Any four bowlers. Three games. No individual shall be eligible to bowl more than two (2) times in the Team event. Not more than two (2) players on the same Team may place more than once in the prize list for Team position standings. No more than two (2) bowlers may compete together more than once in the Team event. First score bowled in Team counts toward All-Event total. **Doubles/Singles:** Any two bowlers. Three games Doubles, then three games Singles on adjacent pair. Averages determine division. No individual shall be eligible to bowl more than once in Doubles and Singles events. If a Bowler/Substitute enters the Singles event, they must also enter the Doubles event. Substitutions may be made in either event in the case of emergency.
14. Team event entrants may only have one (1) ball for use on the return rack.
15. Claims of errors in score keeping must be filed with NLAC Association Manager in writing within seventy- two (72) hours of the time the error was made.
16. The Tournament Committee shall act as judges and settle all questions not covered by either the NLAC or the USBC Rule Book.
17. USBC Rule 320 gives Tournament Officials the right to move participants to lanes other than those assigned. Scores shall be continued from the last frame completed by the individual. No practice balls allowed.
18. TARDY bowlers shall start in the frame currently being bowled. A zero (0) shall be scored for all missed frames. There shall be no BLIND scores or pacers.
19. Additional squads shall be added if all regular squads are filled prior to entry closing date. Squads may be dropped if not needed.
20. Protests must be filed with the Tournament Director in writing within 72 hours after the close of the tournament. All decisions of the tournament director are final.

The penalty for violation of any portion of these rules shall be possible suspension from USBC. Such suspension shall remain in force until removed by the legal committee of the USBC.

A Contract of Mutual Responsibility: *To the Association Manager of the North Los Angeles County Bowling Association (NLAC USBC), acting for those whose names appear on this entry form. I hereby enter those listed in the events indicated and all agree to abide by the tournament and playing rules and regulations prescribed by the NLAC USBC, including all provisions set forth on the entry form, together with the playing rules and regulations of the United States Bowling Congress. Entry fees as shown on this entry form, are herewith enclosed for the events entered. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized substitutes hereby agree that the NLAC USBC, it's Officers and other agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when this Team shall be prevented from bowling any event in this Tournament, which may be brought about by fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the NLAC USBC. "Premature termination of the Tournament brought about by war, national emergency causes relating thereto or there from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of the NLAC USBC shall cause the foregoing prize schedule to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination".*
